**Signing of the Financing Contract for “ROHU00172 - CCSA - Closer to citizens for a Safer Area”**

On March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025, the financing contract no. 54572 for the project “ROHU00172 - CCSA - Closer to Citizens for a Safer Area” was signed. This project is financed under the Interreg VI-A Romania-Hungary Programme, with “Avram Iancu” Border Police Training School Oradea acting as Leader.

The overall objective of the project is to increase the level of security and bring about a change by raising the awareness of citizens about border control measures and legal provisions in cross-border areas.

This project is being implemented by the “Avram Iancu” Border Police Training School Oradea (SPAPFAI) - Project Leader, in partnership with the Police Education and Training Center in Szeged, Hungary (ROKK) - Partner2.

The expected results include:

- Organizing activities related to project implementation (opening conference, workshops and closing conference) and purchase of visibility elements by both partners;
- The establishment of the Digital Information Center RO within “Avram Iancu” Border Police Training School in Oradea;
- Setting up the Hu Digital Information Center within Police Education and Training Center in Szeged, Hungary;
- Conducting two workshops for the development of best practices guide for informing citizens about border-related legal measures;
- Organization of two public campaigns to inform Romanian and Hungarian citizens about border control measures, legal provisions and compliance with the legal system of the state border;

The total value of the project is **154,339.92 euro**, of which **123,471.93 euro** represents **80%** non-reimbursable external funding (ERDF).

The project’s implementation period is 12 months, from March 07, 2025, to March 06, 2026.
